DIVAI wines are proudly defined by their genuine character, elegance, heritage of thousands of years of the Wine Culture and History in Portugal, but designed for contemporary wine lovers, who surch for the identity of indigenous grapes and for the respect of sustainable pratices.

## Origins



Created in 2014, DIVAI wines are produced in our Estate "Herdade dos Casarões", located near the historical village of Estremoz, on the magical landscape of Alentejo, a wine region for more than 2000 years ago.

"Wine" and comes from the influence of French colonization of Madagascar. The French spoke about wine, referring to it as "du vin". And for the locals it sound like "divai". As they didn't have any word for wine, something that was unknown until then for them, they started to use that expression to name the wine.







#### DNA

DIVAI wines express the character of the soil and climate, as well as the knowledge and passion of the Winemaking Team. And also for sure, the dedication and experience of the women and men that work everyday on the vineyards and winery.



# Vineyards, Soil and Climate

- The vineyards area is around 55 ha and their age goes from 15 years to 25 years.
- The soil is a mix of limestone-clay and shistus, therefore very dry and mineral.
- The climate is deeply continental, with cold winters and very hot summers, few rain, and also with a big thermal amplitude. Therefore the natural acidity of the grapes is excellent.





## Grapes



- The grapes are mainly indigenous, reflecting their best expression and most of our wines are DOC
- White grapes: Arinto, Antão Vaz, Roupeiro, Alvarinho, Viognier
- Red grapes: Touriga Nacional, Aragonês, Trincadeira, Castelão, Alicante Bouschet, Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot



## Concept and authenticity

- DIVAI are concept wines, presenting a diversity of styles, with single varieties and blends, featuring the most unique Portuguese grapes and reflecting the authenticity of the terroir.
- DIVAI wines have minimum oak influence, in order to privilege the grapes natural flavours and freshness.
- The addition of S02 is low
- Divai wines are suitable for Vegans






#### Sustainable Practices





- This is a severe dry region, where the average annual precipitation is 560 mm/m2.
- To save water resources, which are each time more precious, we only use water from our own natural spring, for irrigation
- And because biodiverity is fundamental for the ecossistems balance, we also have several ha of olive trees, with more than 100 years old, and cork trees.





#### Sustainable Practices

- For pest control, we use mostly mechanical tilling of our soils instead of spraying. We do the best effort to use the minimum of chemicals on any treatment, either on the vineyards, on the winery and on the bottling.
- The sustainable practices we apply in our vineyards is our way of preserving the environment conditions, and of ensuring that the land we love, is here for the next generations. It is a matter of consciousness as well as the legacy we want to leave.
- And the immediate result of these practices is that our vineyards become stronger, better able to grow healthy, with more concentrated grapes, which is shown in the authenticity of our wines. The evidence can be found inside each bottle.


